



Head Size: 21"

Yarn: Patons Classic Wool or any same weight/gauge yarn

Weight: 1 Ball 100g/3.5oz (223 yds.)

Color: That's Blue

Gauge: 5 sts. = 1"

Supplies: $1~\mathrm{US}$ size 7, 16" circular needle, $4~\mathrm{size}$ $7~\mathrm{dpns}$, ring marker, tape measure, and darning needle.

Cast on: 110 sts

Join and place ring marker (slip at the beginning of each round)

Begin with K1P1 rib until edge of hat measures 1 1/2"

Begin stockinette stitch and continue until hat measures 8 or more inches.

Decrease Rounds:

Rnd 1 - k3, k2 tog (88sts remain)

Work a knit round

Rnd 2 - k2, k2 tog

Work a knit round

 $\mathbf{Rnd} \ \mathbf{3} - \mathbf{k1}, \ \mathbf{k2tog}$

Work a knit round

 $Rnd\ 4 - k2tog(\ change\ to\ dpns\ and\ divide\ sts)$

Work a knit round

Rnd5-k2tog(11sts remain)

Cut yarn and draw through remaining sts. Weave in all ends.
